

That is the area I want you to also correct that Evian is in-charge of this area. As a matter of fact, historically Enogies are not posted to this area because of Evian

n the 11th century, a dreaded monster which resembles this kind of ster from no where suddenly appeared in Benin Empire. It killed and swallowed many Binis. This happened during the banishment of Owodo the elder brother of Evian. This dreaded Monster used to come out from Ikpoba River, although the Binis then believed that it was coming from the Sky, but It attacked and devoured many Binis at will at the Ogiso market. The Binis as a result, nicknamed the Ogiso market Agbado Aigbare, meaning we go there together, we never return together, which is how Ogiso market acquired its current name of Agbado market.

Every effort according to historians to tackle this dreaded Monster, including spiritual means failed until Evian the younger brother of Owodo succeeded in throwing a fire-hot iron into the mouth of the Monster. This sent the Monster
